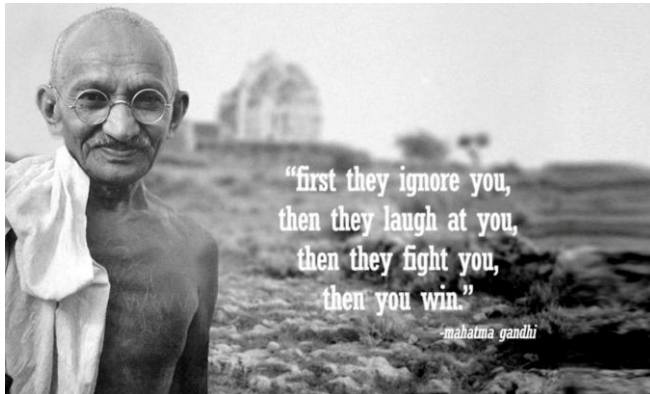


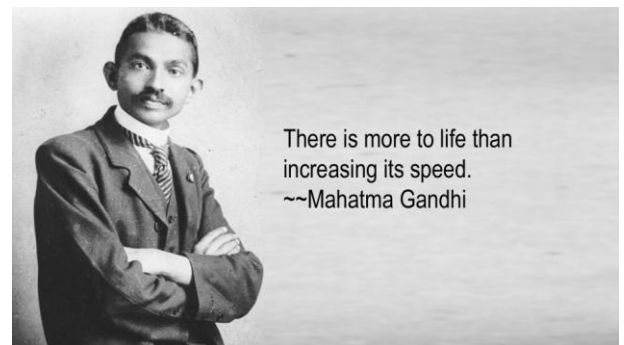
Ghandi¹:

Notes
